CIRCULAR FOR PARENTS OF NURSERY TO CLASS 11th STUDENTS

Dear Parents,

We could not share all the happenings of last session and the planning of coming session 2020-21. I would like to draw your attention to some important points regarding commencement of new session which are as follows:-

The School is working on creating virtual infrastructure of all classes and sections. Email ID for every student and login details will be communicated in due course.

BOOKS, NOTE-BOOKS AND STATIONERY:

The books, note-books and stationery list is already uploaded on school website and shared with all through school's Whatsapp number as well. We assume that due to this long lockdown, vendors may have not received books from publishing houses yet, please don't worry about it, we have asked our educators to share PDFs of lessons during online classes. We expect after lockdown books will be available on shops, you may purchase from any shop of your choice.

REPORT CARDS OF PREVIOUS SESSION:

Report cards of previous year (2019-20) will be handed over once school resumes normal functioning.

UNIFORM:

There is no change in school uniform for session 2020-21. Uniform details are already available on school website, you can purchase the same from any shop of your choice.

SCHOOL REOPENING:

At the moment, working is going on regarding schools reopening dates. Looking at the scenario, we expect that normal school functioning will be resumed in July/August. Exact date and timings will be communicated to you after getting clarity from administration.

SAFETY NORMS FOR STUDENTS AND STAFF:

Concern Government bodies and administration are working on setting up the norms/guidelines for ensuring health and safety of students and staff in schools. As you might have experienced in past that Ekayanaa School always believes in following norms/guidelines for welfare of students and staff, we assure you that first we will ensure the implementation of all safety guidelines and then only we will reopen school for students.

SYLLABUS:

CBSE has already confirmed that they will be making concession in the syllabus of the board classes. We will brainstorm and revamp the syllabus for other classes so that effective learning takes place during this time. Assessments, activities, events etc. can be rationalized, planned and integrated with academics in such a way that it addresses the learning needs of various subjects.

Also, to cover up the syllabus and ensure the proper transaction of our annual learning programme in all classes, we have time till mid-April, 2021, while the second half of April 2021 can be utilized for annual exams. This way we will be getting nearly 40 extra working days to compensate the loss.

This is how we intend to ensure that our Ekayanites do not lose out on any aspect of learning during this difficult time.
