1. Result declaration and Parent Teacher Meeting will be held as follows:

Classes V to VIII : Friday, 31.03.2023

(Timings: Classes V & VI: 9:00 to 11:00 am, Classes VII & VIII: 11:30 am to 2:00 pm)

Sr.KG to Class IV: Saturday, 01.04.2023

(Timings: Sr.KG to Class II: 8:30 to 11:00 am, Classes III & IV: 11:30 am to 2:00 pm)

- 2. Kindly check that your ward's pending fee till academic session 2022-23 is cleared before Parent Teacher Meeting.
- 3. Academic session 2023-24 will commence from Wednesday, 5th April, 2023 for classes VI to IX and classes I to V on Monday, 10th April, 2023.
- 4. In case your ward will not be continuing schooling at Ekayanaa School in the next academic session because of any personal or professional reasons, kindly inform us the same before 25th March, 2023 positively by email on info@ekayanaaschool.com. TC will be processed after clearing of the due fee till academic session 2022-23.

In absence of prior intimation of withdrawal, we will take it that you wish your ward to continue schooling with us for next session. In case of withdrawal without prior information till 25th March, 2023, the 1st installment of the tuition fee for academic session 2023-24 will have to be paid.
