NEW INITIATIVES

1. **It's my turn:** Under this programme, subject teachers will suggest topic to students to prepare and present in front of class for about 3 to 4 minutes. The topics will be chosen from their various subjects. The objectives of this programme is to provide an opportunity to every single student in the class to present himself/herself. It will also help in improving effective communication, public speaking abilities, research, lateral thinking and developing presentation skills. Needless to say this programme is an attempt to develop self confidence among children. Details of the programme is already explained to students by the educators. There will be one cycle in a month in which every single student will get an opportunity for presentation.

2. **A word everyday: "Every single drop contributes to make an ocean"**. Under this programme, a word with its meaning and usage is introduced to

students on every day basis. When students will learn 80 to 100 words, a quiz in the form of Spell Bee will be conducted for students (There may be 4 quizzes in a session). The objective of this programme is to enhance vocabulary, writing skills, speaking skills and to develop effective

communication with use of good and appropriate words.
