- The Evaluation pattern shall be followed as per the latest CBSE guidelines.
- It is mandatory to take ALS (Assessment of Listening and Speaking Skills) in English & Hindi.
- All projects and practical files of different subjects are to be submitted by defined dates.

PROMOTION POLICY

1. The weightage of different examinations is as under

Major Tests - 1	5%
Half Yearly Examination/Major Test-2	10%
Major Test-3	15%
Final Examination	70%
2. Minimum 33% marks in each subject, in aggregate; as well as in Final Examination is required to be declared as 'PASS'.
3. **It is essential to pass in both - the theory and practicals/project separately in subjects with practicals/projects.**

POLICY REGARDING ABSENTEES IN ANY EXAMINATION

1. Appearing in Half Yearly Examination and Final Examination is mandatory. No examination will be conducted either before or after the scheduled date and time. A student absent from any examination without any substantial reason will be marked absent for the exam. A minimum of 75% attendance is mandatory to appear for the Board Examination.
2. If a student has not appeared in an examination without any genuine reason and has not submitted her/his leave application, she/he will be marked absent and will be awarded a ZERO.
3. If a student does not appear in any of the examinations because of medical reasons (subject to submission of an application along with relevant medical documents/certificate) or due to representing the school in Inter-School competitions, she/he would be allowed to give that examination on some alternative date/s given by the school.
