Committees and their agendas on which our students delegates discussed during Environment Summit are:

Air Pollution Committee- Causes of air pollution with special focus on harmful gases preventive measures and sustainable plans.

Biodiversity Committee- Threats to Biodiversity and eliminating risk factors for vulnerable, endangered and rare species.

Forest Exploitation Committee- Disadvantages of forest exploitation and conservation of plant kingdom and animal kingdom.
