On 17th and 18th April, a number of skill-oriented workshops will be organized. Workshop options are offered in two groups, students may choose to attend one workshop of their interest from each group.

Skill-Based Workshops (Group -1)	Performing Art Workshops (Group -2)
Photography (Basic photography skills, including composition, lighting, and creative visual)	Theatre and film making through dramatics (Self-expression, overcoming stage fright etc.)
Artificial Intelligence (Basic understanding of Artificial Intelligence, including how machines learn)	Vocal Singing (Develop basic vocal skills, rhythm, and confidence in singing)
Robotics through Coding (Problem solving through robotics, coding)	Classical Dance (Basics of Kathak Dance)
Radio Jockeying (Scripting, voice modulation, content & research, radio drama etc.)	Western Dance (Dance styles like free style and contemporary.)
Story Weaving and Narration (Develop creativity, confidence, and communication skills)	Fabric Printing (Hands-on learning textile art and printing techniques.)

- For specialized workshops, resources and resource persons will be arranged from various agencies outside of school; hence an amount of Rs 400/- will be deducted from imprest money account of students.
- Material for activities/workshops will be provided from school.
